#### INTRODUCTION

Our Lord has provided us this letter, as part of the whole Bible, so that we can know how we ought to conduct ourselves or behave ourselves, how we ought to act, how we ought to live, in the church. To press this to our consciences, to make these instructions powerful and memorable to us, the Holy Spirit caused what we call "the church" to be described in three ways. Last week, we considered the church as the house of God. In the Old Testament days, a physical structure was the house of God: the tabernacle or the temple. In these New Testament days, the disciples of Jesus Christ together are God's house, God's building. Today we take up the next phrase, and see that what we call 'the church" is the assembly or congregation of the living God.

#### **TEXT**

1 Timothy 3:14-15

#### **BODY**

What we call "the church" is the assembly or congregation of the living God.

- I. What We Call "The Church" Is, in the Original Greek, the Ekklesia
  - A. Greek ekklesia
  - B. That is the Greek word in this place, and in many other places in the New Testament
    - 1. examples
    - 2. wherever in the Bible you are used to reading or hearing the English word "church," the original Greek word is *ekklesia*
  - C. The etymology of that word gives us some understanding what it means here
    - 1. ek = out
    - 2. kaleo = to call
    - 3. so, the concept of people who were called out of their normal place or activity
  - D. History tells us that in the Greek culture the *ekklesia* was a meeting or assembly of the citizens, usually to debate or decide political questions
  - E. So, the Greek word ekklesia gives us a two-part idea:
    - 1. people are called out
    - 2. to come to a meeting; to come to an assembly; to form a congregation

- II. In the Old Testament Scriptures, *Ekklesia* Referred to Israel, as Called By God to Assemble Before Him As a Congregation
  - A. The scriptures record that, in the days of OT Israel, God would have one of His servants call Israel to gather before Him; this included two aspects
    - 1. the people were called
    - 2. the people met together; they assembled; they congregated
  - B. When the Old Testament was translated into Greek, before the time Jesus came, this was translated by the Greek word *ekklesia*.
    - 1. Ekklesia means literally "called out."
    - 2. But it was used to mean gathering or assembly or congregation that formed when men were called out to assemble.
    - 3. Therefore, it made a good word for this Old Testament phenomenon of God calling Israel to assemble before Him
  - C. Here are some examples of when Israel was gathered before the Lord, and that congregation or assembly was called the *ekklesia* 
    - 1. Deu 4:9-10 God said to Moses, at Mt Sinai, "Gather the people to Me, and I will let them hear My words, that they may learn to fear Me all the days they live on the earth, and that they may teach their children," then He spoke to them the Ten Commandments; when that was translated into Greek, it was called the *ekklesia*. Deu 9:10 (all versions read "assembly")
    - 2. Joshua 8:33-35 Joshua led all Israel in worship, including reading the Bible to them, all Israel, gathered to worship; when that was translated into Greek, it was called the *ekklesia*. (GEN, KJV congregation NKJV, ESV assembly)
    - 3. 1 Kings 8:1-2, 14 When the temple had been built under King Solomon, the King assembled all the leaders of Israel, and all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto the King; when that was translated into Greek, it was called the *ekklesia*. (GEN, KJV congregation NKJV, ESV assembly)
    - 4. Nehemiah 7:5, 66 Nehemiah gathered those Israelites who had returned from exile in Babylon, back to Jerusalem, so they could be registered by genealogy; that gathering, when that was translated into Greek, was called the *ekklesia*. (GEN, KJV congregation NKJV, ESV assembly)
    - 5. Joel 2:15-16, 28-32 God, by the prophet Joel, called for the people to be gathered, and told them to pray to the Lord, that He would save them, and prophesied to them about the days when the Holy Spirit would be poured out, and that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved; when that was translated into Greek, it was called the *ekklesia*. (all versions read "congregation")
  - D. So, from the Old Testament, we know that the word ekklesia describes this thing:
    - 1. God, by His human messenger, calls for His people to come to him, gathering to worship Him
    - 2. in such a gathering, God's law and His gospel are proclaimed, and the people pray to God, thanking Him, praising Him, confessing their sins, and crying to Him to save them
  - E. So, when the New Testament had not yet been written, this Old Testament thing already was known to God's people in the Greek language as G1577 the *ekklesia*.
  - F. The Lord Jesus and His disciples then used that word, *ekklesia*, to name the New Covenant gathering or assembly or congregation of the disciples of Jesus Christ.

- III. The Pagans Where Timothy Lived Also Called Their Assembly the Ekklesia
  - A. Acts 19:23-41 "assembly" in verses 32, 39, 41
    - 1. note that this happened in Ephesus,
      - a) Paul was there when this happened
      - b) this is where Timothy was working when Paul wrote him this letter
    - 2. the people of the city all came together in the theater
    - 3. supposedly they were defending the honor of their goddess Artemis, or Diana
    - 4. actually they were defending the money some of them made from the sale of religious paraphernalia
  - B. Even in an assembly called in the name of the false goddess Diana or Artemis, the town clerk scolded the Ephesians for their behavior
    - 1. Acts 19:36 they were being loud when they should have been quiet
    - 2. Acts 19:36 they were prepared to do something rash
    - 3. Acts 19:39 their assembly was not lawful
    - 4. Acts 19:40 they were in danger of getting in trouble from higher powers
    - 5. Acts 19:40 what they were doing was not in keeping with the purpose of that assembly
    - 6. Acty 19:40 their assembly was a "concourse" or "commotion" or "disorderly gathering"
  - C. So, in Ephesus, as in the surrounding Graeco-Roman pagan culture, the *ekklesia* was a meeting of the people either for secular political purposes, or, at least in the case of the riot in Ephesus, for supposedly religious purposes related to false gods like Diana or Artemis

- IV. What We Call the Church Is the Ekklesia or Congregation of the Living God
  - A. The phrase "the living God" is used many places in the Bible to distinguish the one true God from all false notions of gods
    - 1. e.g. Jeremiah 10:1-16
  - B. So, our Lord's apostle here identifies what we call "the church" as the congregation not of any dead statue of wood or stone or metal, but of the living God.
  - C. If even the pagan city clerk of Ephesus scolded the *ekklesia* of Ephesus, assembled in the name of a lifeless false goddess made of silver, for their unruly behavior, how much more should we, who are the *ekklesia*, the congregation of the living God, be careful to conduct ourselves, to behave ourselves, as is fitting for those of His congregation

What we call the church is the ekklesia or congregation of the living God

#### V. CONCLUSION

- A. It is a very ancient institution for the worshipers of the living God to be called by His servants to assemble, to form a congregation, for worship, and for that congregation to consist of the whole number of the people concerned
  - 1. therefore, men in positions of leadership, whether religious or civic leaders, should not think it within their purview to stop religious bodies from assembling to worship
    - a) whether in the days of established churches, when the establishment tried to stop the Baptists from assembling
    - b) nor today, when the powers that be in many jurisdictions try to stop the churches from assembling for worship, or from assembling as the full congregation
  - 2. nor should it be the practice of individual worshipers not to assemble
- B. The delivery of content to be consumed is not the essence of the *ekklesia*; therefore electronic delivery cannot sufficiently substitute for in-person gathering.
- C. What many people call "the church," is a world-wide religious organization with Antichrist, the Pope in Rome, as its head. That organization is man-made. It has a man-made structure, man-made offices, man-made doctrine, man-made worship. That organization is not the biblical *ekklesia*. What we call "the church" is not what the Roman Catholics call "the church."
- D. In no place in the New Testament does the word *ekklesia* refer to the building where the congregation assembles for worship.
  - 1. in many languages, a form of the word "church" means the building where the congregation meets for worship
  - 2. but most of those languages have a different word for translating *ekklesia* so that the building is called the church, but the congregation is called something else
  - 3. it is a quirk of English that we use the word "church" to mean the building, but we use the same word "church" to mean the congregation
  - 4. in the early 1500s, William Tyndale translated *ekklesia* as "congregacion;" but that did not endure; from the 1560 Geneva Bible on through the King James and after, *ekklesia* has been translated as "church"
  - 5. so, as English speakers, we have that in our Bibles, but we need to teach our children, that what our English Bibles call 'the church" is not any building, but is the congregation of the living God!

- So, when the New Testament had not yet been written, this Old Testament concept was already known in the Greek language as G1577 the *ekklesia*.

The Lord Jesus and His disciples then used that word, *ekklesia*, to name the New Covenant gathering or assembly or congregation of the disciples of Jesus Christ.

There is nowhere in the Bible that the word "church" means the building in which the Christians meet for worship.

# G1577 in NT regarding secular assembly

Acts 19:23-41 NKJV And about that time there arose a great commotion about the Way. 24 For a certain man named Demetrius, a silversmith, who made silver shrines of Diana, brought no small profit to the craftsmen. 25 He called them together with the workers of similar occupation, and said: "Men, you know that we have our prosperity by this trade. 26 Moreover you see and hear that not only at Ephesus, but throughout almost all Asia, this Paul has persuaded and turned away many people, saying that they are not gods which are made with hands. 27 So not only is this trade of ours in danger of falling into disrepute, but also the temple of the great goddess Diana may be despised and her magnificence destroyed, whom all Asia and the world worship." 28 Now when they heard this, they were full of wrath and cried out, saying, "Great is Diana of the Ephesians!" 29 So the whole city was filled with confusion, and rushed into the theater with one accord, having seized Gaius and Aristarchus, Macedonians, Paul's travel companions. 30 And when Paul wanted to go in to the people, the disciples would not allow him. 31 Then some of the officials of Asia, who were his friends, sent to him pleading that he would not venture into the theater. 32 Some therefore cried one thing and some another, for the assembly was confused, and most of them did not know why they had come together. 33 And they drew Alexander out of the multitude, the Jews putting him forward. And Alexander motioned with his hand, and wanted to make his defense to the people. 34 But when they found out that he was a Jew, all with one voice cried out for about two hours, "Great is Diana of the Ephesians!" 35 And when the city clerk had quieted the crowd, he said: "Men of Ephesus, what man is there who does not know that the city of the Ephesians is temple guardian of the great goddess Diana, and of the image which fell down from Zeus? 36 Therefore, since these things cannot be denied, you ought to be quiet and do nothing rashly. 37 For you have brought these men here who are neither robbers of temples nor blasphemers of your goddess. 38 Therefore, if Demetrius and his fellow craftsmen have a case against anyone, the courts are open and there are proconsuls. Let them bring charges against one another. 39 But if you have any other inquiry to make, it shall be determined in the lawful assembly. 40 For we are in danger of being called in question for today's uproar, there being no reason which we may give to account for this disorderly gathering." 41 And when he had said these things, he dismissed the assembly.

Romans 16:16 NKJV Greet one another with a holy kiss. The churches of Christ greet you.

Romans 16:23 NKJV Gaius, my host and the host of the whole church, greets you. Erastus, the treasurer of the city, greets you, and Quartus, a brother.

- 1 Corinthians 1:2 NKJV To the church of God which is at Corinth, to those who are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all who in every place call on the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours:
- 1 Corinthians 4:17 NKJV For this reason I have sent Timothy to you, who is my beloved and faithful son in the Lord, who will remind you of my ways in Christ, as I teach everywhere in every church.
- 1 Corinthians 6:4 NKJV If then you have judgments concerning things pertaining to this life, do you appoint those who are least esteemed by the church to judge?
- 1 Corinthians 7:17 NKJV But as God has distributed to each one, as the Lord has called each one, so let him walk. And so I ordain in all the churches.
- 1 Corinthians 10:32 NKJV Give no offense, either to the Jews or to the Greeks or to the church of God,
- 1 Corinthians 11:16 NKJV But if anyone seems to be contentious, we have no such custom, nor do the churches of God.
- 1 Corinthians 11:18 NKJV For first of all, when you come together as a church, I hear that there are divisions among you, and in part I believe it.

- 1 Corinthians 14:28 NKJV But if there is no interpreter, let him keep silent in church, and let him speak to himself and to God.
- 1 Corinthians 14:33 NKJV For God is not the author of confusion but of peace, as in all the churches of the saints.
- 1 Corinthians 14:34 NKJV Let your women keep silent in the churches, for they are not permitted to speak; but they are to be submissive, as the law also says.
- 1 Corinthians 14:35 NKJV And if they want to learn something, let them ask their own husbands at home; for it is shameful for women to speak in church.
- 1 Corinthians 15:9 NKJV For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.
- 1 Corinthians 16:1 NKJV Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given orders to the churches of Galatia, so you must do also:
