Pamagat: Ang Mga Kalunos-lunos na Bunga ng Pagtitiwalag (The Tragic Consequences of Apostasy)

**Hosea 9:1-17** "Rejoice not, O Israel, for joy, as other people: for thou hast gone a whoring from thy God, thou hast loved a reward upon every cornfloor. 2 The floor and the winepress shall not feed them, and the new wine shall fail in her. 3 They shall not dwell in the LORD'S land; but Ephraim shall return to Egypt, and they shall eat unclean things in Assyria. 4 They shall not offer wine offerings to the LORD, neither shall they be pleasing unto him: their sacrifices shall be unto them as the bread of mourners; all that eat thereof shall be polluted: for their bread for their soul shall not come into the house of the LORD. 5 What will ye do in the solemn day, and in the day of the feast of the LORD? 6 For, lo, they are gone because of destruction: Egypt shall gather them up, Memphis shall bury them: the pleasant places for their silver, nettles shall possess them: thorns shall be in their tabernacles.

7 The days of visitation are come, the days of recompence are come; Israel shall know it: the prophet is a fool, the spiritual man is mad, for the multitude of thine iniquity, and the great hatred. 8 The watchman of Ephraim was with my God: but the prophet is a snare of a fowler in all his ways, and hatred in the house of his God. 9 They have deeply corrupted themselves, as in the days of Gibeah: therefore he will remember their iniquity, he will visit their sins. 10 I found Israel like grapes in the wilderness; I saw your fathers as the firstripe in the fig tree at her first time: but they went to Baalpeor, and separated themselves unto that shame; and their abominations were according as they loved.

11 As for Ephraim, their glory shall fly away like a bird, from the birth, and from the womb, and from the conception.
12 Though they bring up their children, yet will I bereave them, that there shall not be a man left: yea, woe also to them when I depart from them! 13 Ephraim, as I saw Tyrus, is planted in a pleasant place: but Ephraim shall bring forth his children to the murderer. 14 Give them, O LORD: what wilt thou give? give them a miscarrying womb and dry breasts.
15 All their wickedness is in Gilgal: for there I hated them: for the wickedness of their doings I will drive them out of mine house, I will love them no more: all their princes are revolters. 16 Ephraim is smitten, their root is dried up, they shall bear no fruit: yea, though they bring forth, yet will I slay even the beloved fruit of their womb. 17 My God will cast them away, because they did not hearken unto him: and they shall be wanderers among the nations."

#### Panimula:

The nation was deserving of the "days of visitation" and the "days of recompense." They were hostile to God and even called his prophets (like Hosea) "fool" and "mad" (9:7).

# I. God Removes the Joy of Their Religious Activities Because of Apostasy. (vv.1-6)

- A. "a reward upon every cornfloor" Akala nila na may gantimapala sila sa mga dios-diosan na sinasamba nila at iniaalay ng mga handog.
- B. Ang araw ng Dios, ay dapat pista pero dahil sa kanilang pagtiwalag sa pananampalataya, ito ay naging mga araw ng pagtataranta.

### **II.** God Dooms Them to Utter Destruction Because of Apostasy. (vv.7-10)

- A. "days of visitation" and "days of recompense" Assyria's take over.
- B. Anino ito ng Day of the LORD para sa buong bansa ng Israel.
- C. "days of Gibeah" rape and murder according to Judges 19.
- D. "wickedness in Gilgal" -(v.15) idolatry and immorality.
- E. "Baalpeor" Baal of Peor A mountain east of Jordan in Moab. Baal (means "master" this is a Phonecian diety).

## **III.** God Destroys Their Heritage Because of Apostasy. (vv.11-17)

- A. Ang glory ng Ephraim ay aalis na parang ibon (madali at hindi na ito babalik ng kanyang sarili).
- B. Magiging baog sila sa espiritual na kalagayan muna tapos susunod ang physical na kalagayan.
- C. Mahirap ang talikuran ang Dios.

#### Katapusan:

- 1. Ang Israel ay umabot sa kaginhawaan at kayamanan ng paghahari ni King Jeroboam II.
- 2. Pero dahil dito at kasama na rin ang kanilang pagtitiwalag sa Dios ay hahatulan sila ng Dios.
