Remember Your Redemption – Rest in His Resurrection

1 Peter 1:17-21

Last week: With clear minds that are continually prepared for action set your hope fully on the grace of Jesus Christ, then actively resist being conformed to the world AND actively pursue holy living in all your conduct with the confidence that the Holy One who called you will complete the work to conform you to Christ! (1 Peter 1:13-16)

1. Remember the same One you call **Father** is also the impartial Judge to whom we all must give an account – v.17
 - a. 'conduct becoming a child of God'
 - b. throughout the time of your exile...

2. Remember your **redemption** from slavery to sin is only accomplished by the precious blood of Christ – v.18-19
 - a. negative – do NOT hope in the great things the world has to offer – mere silver or gold
 - b. positive – DO hope in most precious price ever paid

3. Remember that the **revelation** of Jesus Christ is something special to be studied and savored – v.20
 - a. eternally existent
 - b. made manifest *for the sake of you*

4. Remember that any strength we have for enduring faith or living hope is found in the **resurrection** of Jesus Christ from the dead – v.21
 - a. *through Him* – in Christ alone

b. *enduring faith and living hope*
