Apply the Text:

- Stop stressing out about the present.
 - Open your eyes and take a fresh, objective look at your problem.
 - o Open your ears and listen to His word by identifying verses to read and memorize.
 - o Open your heart and trust in His enabling by recounting God's enabling in the past.
- Stop fretting about the future.
 - Wait on God's timing to expand your influence. (Pray I Chron. 4:9-10)
 - o Rest in God's provision for your protection. (Meditate on 2 Tim. 1:7)
 - o Reflect on your contribution to the GRAND STORY. (Reflect on I Cor. 10:6 & 11; Rom. 8:28)
 - o Recommit to making His glory your guiding motivation. (Memorize I Cor. 10:31)
