"The Conviction of Things Not Seen"

1. Certainty in the unseen God (Heb. 11:1).
 - a. The "substance" of things hoped for. (Heb. 11:1).
 - b. The visible comes from the invisible. (Heb. 11:3; Gen. 1:1; Acts 14:15-17; Acts 17:24-29)
 - c. This certainty is real. (Job 38:1-4; Ps. 14:1; Ps. 19:1; Rom. 1:18-23)
 - d. This certainty includes Christ. (Heb. 2:8-9; 10:26-31; Acts 2:22-23, 29-36; Acts 17:30-31; 1 Cor. 15:1-8).
2. Certainty must orient your life (11:3).
 - a. "By faith we understand...."
 - b. Faith produces action. (James 2:17; Heb. 10:19ff; Rom. 12:1; Jn. 14:15; Heb. 11:4-16).
3. Certainty will commend you to God (11:2).
 - a. Works without faith are not good. (Heb. 11:6; 1 Sam. 15:22-23; Mk. 12:33-34)
 - b. Faith commends. (Gen. 15:6; Rom. 10:9-13; Heb. 11:2).
 - c. "God has prepared for them a city."
