The Pre-Tribulation Rapture

If you are saved, you are "delivered" from the "wrath" of Hell's "lake of fire" and the "wrath" of every part of the seven-year Tribulation period after the rapture of the church.

The Meaning of "Endure"

Paul wanted to mention that he "endured" all of these difficulties that came upon him. He said, "what persecutions I endured." The word for "endure" is HYPOPHERO. Some of the meanings for this are as follows:

"to bear by being under, bear up (a thing placed on one's shoulders); to bear patiently, to endure"

This is truly a descriptive word picture. It meant that when heavy weights were placed upon Paul's shoulders, he was still able to remain standing up despite such a load.
