I) The Substance of the Gospel Promise

• We are God's holy temple, established in Christ.

1) They shall be made Perfect

- "perfect" means "fully ready, to put in full order, complete"
- Heb. 13:20-21; Heb. 10:5
- Phil. 4:13; Eph 6:13-18
- God equips the Christian for the battle

2) They Shall be Established

- "established" means "to keep firm and steadfast"
- 2 Thess. 3:3
- Rom 8:38,39

3) They shall be strengthened

- 2 Cor. 10:3-5
- Isa 41:10
- Isa 40:29-31

4) They shall be settled

- "settled" means "to make to rest securely" as a building on its foundation;
- Christ is our sure foundation;
- God's purpose is to settle His people on the rock of Christ;
- Trials and temptations cause us to cling to Christ, not ourselves.

5) He who does all of this for them is God
