4. Read **Romans 8:28** and **Genesis 50:20**. What does the Genesis verse (and its associated story) do to keep you from oversimplifying the Romans verse?
5. Read **2 Corinthians 6:2-10**. How can and should this passage embolden us as Christians to confidently seek to advance the kingdom message of repentance and salvation this week?
