- I. A Grand Entrance.
 - A. The ark's entrance into Jerusalem is a fitting picture of Christ's ascension.
 - 1. Because of what the ark represented.
 - 2. Because of what Jerusalem represented.
 - 3. Because of what David meant to teach Israel.
 - B. Both the entrance of the ark into Jerusalem, and Christ's ascension into heaven, were grand entrances. Likewise, our ascension will be grand!
- II. A Victorious Entrance.
 - A. David's act of bringing the ark to Jerusalem was a sign of victory.
 - B. Christ's ascension into heaven was also an indication that He was victorious.
- III. A Blessed Entrance.
 - A. The entrance of the ark signified the king coming to dwell in His established kingdom.
 - B. The entrance of the ark signified the king taking up the covenantal rule of His people.
