Eph 2:8–9 ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not a result of works, so that no one may boast.”



1. The Cross of Calvary is the ultimate example of God's Grace

Heb 7:26: **But we see him who for a little while was made lower than the angels, namely Jesus, crowned with glory and honor because of the suffering of death, so that by the grace of God he might taste death for everyone.**



2. God's Law defines His standard of righteousness, but only grace delivers it!

Exodus 34: 5-7

⁵ The LORD descended in the cloud and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the LORD. ⁶ The LORD passed before him and proclaimed, "The LORD, the LORD, a God merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and abounding in steadfast love and faithfulness, ⁷ keeping steadfast love for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin,...

Four Reasons why God gave his Mosaic Law to His people:

- 1) it was for their own good, giving them guidance in how to live peaceably with men and Him,
- 2) it was to reveal Himself to them,
- 3) it was to set them apart in order to reveal Himself to others.
- 4) it was to reveal humanity's need for a savior.

Romans 3:23-24

for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, **24 and are justified by his grace as a gift, through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus,**

⁸ And when evening came, the owner of the vineyard said to his foreman, 'Call the laborers and pay them their wages, beginning with the last, up to the first.' ⁹ And when those hired about the eleventh hour came, each of them received a denarius. ¹⁰ Now when those hired first came, they thought they would receive more, but each of them also received a denarius. ¹¹ And on receiving it they grumbled at the master of the house,

¹² saying, 'These last worked only one hour, and you have made them equal to us who have borne the burden of the day and the scorching heat.' ¹³ But he replied to one of them, 'Friend, I am doing you no wrong. Did you not agree with me for a denarius? ¹⁴ Take what belongs to you and go. I choose to give to this last worker as I give to you. ¹⁵ Am I not allowed to do what I choose with what belongs to me? Or do you begrudge my generosity?'
