

THE GOLDEN CHAIN

Romans 8:30

I. For Whom He Foreknew

ginōskō - be familiar with, learn to know, through personal experience; have sexual intercourse

proginōskō - to choose or select in advance of some other event; to foreknow, of those whom God elected to salvation; to predestinate

II. He also Predestined

proorízō - to predetermine, decide beforehand

III. These He also Called

Klētós – called; summoned, especially to a request to which refusal is not an option

Dikaióō - to render, declare, pronounce, one to be just,
righteous, or such as he ought to be.

Pístis - what can be believed, a state of certainty with regard to

Edoxasen – Aorist tense of *doxázō*- to glorify, hence “glorified”
