Sermon: "Deception in War" What's Wrong With You People? Pt. 11

I Text:

Old Covenant: Judges 3:12-30 New Covenant: John 20:24-31

II Doctrine:

In the prototypical pattern for the book of Judges the Israelites betray God. This betrayal leads them to be enslaved by the King of Moab. Moab is a well established nation in the historical record.

The children of Israel call upon the Lord who mercifully raises up another Judge. Our second Judge in the narrative Ehud the Benjamite is raised up to deliver his people.

Ehud proves to be a cunning assassin in the way he delivers Israel. After the death of Eglon the King of Moab, the land is given rest for eighty years. Unfortunately the new generation of Israelites forget their deliverance and will continue the cycle of sin.
