- 1. Read **James 4:3-6**. How does the problem of worldliness and pride change the kinds of things you request of God? What are some examples of this?
- 2. Read **Luke 22:42**. What are the problems that surface when we fail to pray with this Luke 22:42 mindset? What can you do to ensure that this attitude saturates your prayer life?
- 3. Read **Deuteronomy 8:11-18**. Why is it so easy for modern Christians to fail to sense their full dependence on God for the provisions of life? What kinds of circumstances tend to wake us up to our desperate need for God's generosity?
- 4. Read **Matthew 6:25-34**. How can this focus on *daily* need and *daily* provision (cf. v.34) help to alleviate worry and anxiety?
- 5. Read **Philippians 4:10-13**. How can the truths presented in this sermon help you to have a genuine sense of contentment when God does not answer your prayers in the way or as quickly as you had hoped?
