All of Matthew's discourses deal with the Kingdom of heaven and are written to the Jews. The Kingdom of heaven's ordained King is the Lord Jesus Christ, who was chosen by God. The New Testament Church is not the object of these discourses.

{ Jesus gives one discourse about the Church in the Gospel of John. It's called "The Upper Room Discourse" in John chapters 13-17. }

NB: A born-again Christian will get the most blessing from John's discourse. Those 5 chapters along, with the Psalms, will draw one close to the Lord. They make a great way to learn and know that the AV 1611 is from God.

"The stones of the Wailing Wall are NOT remains of the Temple.

Rather, they are from the Roman Fort Antonia - the 36 acre, first century garrison that housed the Roman centurions and troops that ruled the city.

The present 'Temple Mount', on which the Dome of the Rock stands, is actually a military site.

The real Temple was located on a 12 acre site two hundred yards SW of the wailing wall.

The Gihon Spring (1 Chron 32:30; 1Kings 1:33) was located on the real Temple site."
