## Doers of the Word James 1:19-27

## Main Point:

Real Christians hear and do the Word of God; therefore, instead of responding to your trials sinfully, go straight to the Word and do what it says.

1. When trials come into your life, be careful you do not respond sinfully.

2. Instead of responding sinfully, go straight to the Word of God.

3. As you hear the Word, make sure you also do what it says.

4. Because this is what real Christians do, thanks to Jesus Christ.
