Sermon Outline

Remember and Return to your First Love

Revelation 2:1-7

I. Introduction:

- Illustration, overview of the letters to the churches, and background on Ephesus

II. Exposition:

A. Address and identification of the author (v.1)

B. Commendation (v.2-3)

➤ “I know your works...”

- Busy in the work of the Lord
- Enduring under trial
- Holding fast to sound doctrine (Acts 20:29ff; 1 John 4:1)

C. Complaint (v.4)

- You have abandoned your first love (2 Cor 11:2-3; Eph 6:24)

D. Correction (v.5ab)

- Remember from where you have fallen (Jer 2:2)
- Repent
- Resume the first work

E. A solemn warning (v.5c)

- You will cease to be a church

F. A promise to the repentant (v.7)

- Eternal life in fellowship with God (Rev 22:1-2)

III. Application:

1. Sound doctrine and love are not mutually exclusive
2. Love for Christ and others is indispensable for the life of the church
