I. Humbly acknowledge God’s sovereign will.

Come now, you who say, “Today or tomorrow we will go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and make a profit.” Instead, you ought to say, “If the Lord wills, we will live and also do this or that” *Js 4:13. Eph. 1:11, Isaiah 45:6-7; 46:9-11; I Cor. 4:19;16:7; Acts 18:21; Hebrews 6:3; James 4:15; Deut. 9:29)*

II. Submissively obey God’s moral will.

“The secret things belong to the Lord our God, but the things revealed belong to us and to our sons forever, that we may observe all the words of this law” *Dt. 29:29.*

Psalm 40:8; Romans 2:17-18; Eph. 5:17; I Thess. 4:3; Deut. 29:29

III. Prayerfully make wise choices.

A. Attitude: reverently seek knowledge and wisdom.

1. Fear of the Lord begins knowledge (Prov 1:7)
2. Fear of the Lord begins wisdom (Prov 9:10)

B. Focus: passionately pursue God’s purpose.

1. We were created to glorify God (Col 1:15-18)
2. We were saved to glorify God (Eph 1:6,12,14)
3. We are being sanctified to glorify God (Rom 8:28-29)

C. Motivation: sincerely love God and others.

1. Love God totally (Mk 12:30)
2. Love your neighbor as yourself (Mk 12:31)
