- 1. The World's Walk: Futile Minds and Futile Lives (17-19)
 - a. Christians must not live like the world we were once part of (17)
 - b. The world's futile thinking laid bare (18-19)
 - i. Darkened in understanding
 - ii. Alienated from true life, which is found in God
 - iii. Hard hearts that prefer ignorance
 - iv. Callous to sin, given up to sensuality
 - v. Greedy to practice every kind of impurity
- 2. The Christian Life: Renewed Minds and a New Self (20-24)
 - a. It comes from the true teaching, hearing, and learning of Jesus (20-21)
 - b. The gospel taught us to put off the old self (22)
 - i. It belongs to your former manner of life
 - ii. It is characterized by corruption and deceitful desires
 - c. The gospel taught us to be made new in the spirit of our minds (23)
 - d. The gospel taught us to put on the new self (24)
 - i. It is created by God, not by our own effort
 - ii. Its pattern is God, not our own ideas of virtue
 - iii. It is characterized by righteousness and holiness
