John 6:41-47

Christ calls sinful men to trust in saving mercy

. Unbelief Stumbles at Christ's Colossal Claims	vv. 41-42
(1) They grumble and complain about Jesus	'Then the Jews complained about Him, because He said, 'I am the bread which came down from heaven.' "
(2) His heavenly origin rejected	
(3) They are taken up with His humble earthly origin	"Is not this Jesus, the son of Joseph, whose father and mother we know?"
. The Savior's Counsel	vv. 43-47
(1) A Warning against murmuring in unbelief (43)	"Do not murmur among yourselves."
(2) A Call to Trust in Saving Mercy (44-47) -1- Man's Inability (because of his sin!) 44a	"No one can come to Me unless"
-"come to Me" = "believe in Me" - Man left to his own sin will not believe!	
·	ss the Father who sent Me draws him, and I will raise him up at the last day."
[1] The Father's efficacious "drawing" - "draw" or "drag" as a fisherman's net - cf. vv. 64-65 - drawn by the working and power of the Spirit of God	
[2] The Father's efficacious teaching "It is	s written in the prophets, 'And they shall all be taught by God.'

- A divinely powerful teaching

Therefore everyone who has heard and learned from the Father comes to Me."

- teaching impressed upon the heart by the Spirit of God!
- truth indelibly written upon the heart by the Spirit of God
- -"Hearing" the Father, and "learning" from the Father

-3- An Appeal to believe 47

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me has everlasting life."

- No contradiction between *sovereign grace* and the *free offer* of the gospel!
