Giving Credit (v. 26-39)

- The king was granted his request "because the gracious hand of my God was upon my request" (Neh. 2:8)
- When they experienced opposition, he said, "The God of heaven will give us success" (Neh. 2:20)
- When the project was finished, he declared, "This work had been done withthe help of our God" (Neh. 6:16)

The Greatest Resource (v. 4-11)

- 1. Prayer should flow out of a sense of DESPERATION and PASSION (v. 4). James 5:17 (ESV) Elijah was a man with a nature like ours, and he prayed fervently that it might not rain, and for three years and six months it did not rain on the earth.
 - "I have been driven many times to my knees by the overwhelming conviction that I had nowhere else to go. My own wisdom and that of those about me seemed insufficient for the day" (Abraham Lincoln)
- 2. Prayer should bring us back to REALITY (v. 5-6a). "True prayer opens the eyes to things not seen before" (J.C. Penney)
- 3. Prayer should bring us face to face with our SIN (v. 6b-7).
- 4. Prayer should center on God's gracious PROMISES (v. 8-10).
- 5. Prayer should inspire BOLDNESS and SPECIFICITY (v. 11).
