#### A. According to the Scriptures

1. OT predictions of the death of Christ 2nd only to His 1st and 2nd Advents

2. Divided into 4 Parts

4. The Crucifixion - Mt 27:32-54; Mk 15:21-39; Lk 23:32-47; Jo 19:16-37

a. Cyrenian man forced to carry the Cross - Mt 27:32; Mk 15:21; Lk 23:26;

b. Gave Christ pain reliever to drink, He refused - Mt 27:33-34; Mk 15:23;

c. Divided His clothes by Lot - Mt 27:35; Mk 15:24; Lk 23:34; Jo 19:23-24

d. Crucified at 9 AM - Mk 15:25;

e. Sign of Crime above His head - Mt 27:37; Mk 15:26; Lk 23:38; Jo 19:19-22

f. Crucified with and mocked by two criminals - Mt 27:38,44; Mk 15:27-28; Lk 23:33, 39-43; Jo 19:18

- g. Christ Prays for those that are Crucifying Him - Lk 23:34;
  - h. Christ provides for His Mother - Jo 19:25-27
  - i. Mocked by Passers by - Mt 27:39-40; Mk 15:29-30;
  - j. Mocked by Religious Leaders - Mt 27:41-44; Mk 15:31-32; Lk 23:34;
  - k. Mocked by Solders - Lk 23:36-37;
  - l. Darkness over the land from 12-3 - Mt 27:45; Mk 15:33; Lk 23:44-45;
  - m. Christ cries out Ps 22:1 - Mt 27:46; Mk 15:34; Jo 19:30
  - n. Confusion about Elijah - Mt 27:47-49; Mk 15:35-36;
  - o. Christ cries out "I thirst" - Jo 19:28-29
  - p. Christ shouts and gives up His spirit - Mt 27:50; Mk 15:37; Lk 23:46;
  - q. Side pierced with spear, legs not broken - Jo 19:31-37
  - q. Veil in the Temple is torn from Top to Bottom, with earthquake - Mt 27:51; Mk 15:38; Lk 23:45;
  - r. Saints raised form dead - Mt 27:52-53;

  - b. Redemption - Mt 20:28; Ac 20:28; Ro 3:23-24; 1 Co 6:19; Eph 1:7; Col 1:14; Heb 9:12; 1 Pe 1:18-19; Rev 5:9
  - c. Reconciliation - Ro 5:10-11; 2 Co 5:18-19; Eph 2:16; Col 1:21-22
  - d. No Condemnation for the believer - Jo 3:18; Ro 8:1
