- I. Belshazzar’s Haughtiness.
 - A. Not only against other men, but against Jehovah, Belshazzar was haughty.

 - B. This haughtiness of Belshazzar is significant for several reasons.

- II. Babylon’s Destruction.
 - A. Written on the wall, Belshazzar saw a prophecy from God that Babylon would be destroyed.

 - B. This prophecy was fulfilled.

 - C. The fulfillment of this prophecy assures us that also the kingdom of AntiChrist will be destroyed!

- III. Jehovah’s Vindication.
 - A. In the destruction of Babylon past and future, Jehovah vindicates His people.

 - B. In the destruction of Babylon past and future, Jehovah vindicates Himself.
