- a. Last days are everything that happen after the Ascension
- b. People of the world are characterized by being
 - i. Lovers of self, Lovers of money, Proud, Arrogant, Abusive, Disobedient to their parents, Ungrateful, Unholy, Heartless, Unappeasable, Slanderous, Without self-control, Brutal, Not loving good, Treacherous, Reckless, Swollen with conceit, Lovers of pleasure rather than God, Having the appearance of godliness but denying it's power
- c. People of God are not to follow after them

V. People of God (10-17)

- a. Imitate Paul as he imitates Christ
- b. Will be persecuted (Acts 14:21-22, 1 Pet 4:7-13)
- c. What Paul wants Timothy to do and to teach the church
 - i. Continue in what he believed
 - ii. Be acquainted with the sacred writings (Scripture)
