Job #39 (42:7 - 17)

- I. Let us Look at Verses 7 9
- A. V. 7- If we didn't have this ending might wonder if Job's friends were right
 - 1. God only speaks to Eliphaz he was proably oldest and represents others
 - 2. God's wrath against Eliphaz in same way Eliphaz's was against Job-32:2 a. God's wrath is not change in passion but disposition -Deut. 29:24, 25
- B. Different ideas as to why God says Job had spoken right and not others
 - 1. Some think it is comparative Job had spoken more right about God
 - 2. Job was right in saying affliction not always sign of great wickedness a. Job sees the eternal view his friends saw only temporal
 - 3. Some say God referring only to what Job says in chapter 40 and 42
- C. God calls Job "My Servant" no higher title than this Matt. 25:21, 23
 - 1. Moses, Caleb -Nm. 12:7; 14:24 David-2 Sm. 7:5; Abraham- Gn. 26:24
- D. V. 8-7 Sacrifices- perfect number -Num. 23:1 come to Job as priest
 - 1. They are following instruction of Christ Matt. 5:23, 24
 - 2. God will accept Job's prayer to bring about His purpose for them
 - a. There is effect in prayer of righteous-Jm. 5:16; Num. 16:46; 1 Jn. 5:16
- E. V. 9- Job again is obeying command of Christ -Matt. 5:44;
- II. Let us Look at verses 10 17
- A. V. 10- Job's receives double not at once- Ps. 14:7; Is. 61:7; Zech. 9:12
- B. V. 11- Family returns- they were not seen earlier-19:13; Prov. 14:20; 17:17
- C. V. 13 Job receives same number of children that he had before
 - 1. Different ideas as to whether he had same wife as before- Job 2:9; 19:17
- D. V. 14- Interestingly, we are given names of daughters, not sons-Num. 27:8
- 1. Jemima- Warm, affectionate, dove or day; Kezia from cassia -Ps. 45:8
- 2. Kerin-Happuch- Horn of cosmetic- cosmetic to make eyes bigger
- E. V 16-Job lives additional 140 years- don't know exact life span
 - 1. Life span of about 200 years puts him in time of Patriarchs
 - 2. Blessing includes long life- Ps. 128:6; Prov. 17:6; Ps. 91:16

Conclusion: Job is looked at favorably by God- Ez. 14:14; James 5:11

- A. Like Job, we make mistakes, but let us speak favorably of God
- B. What things can we do that scripture says is acceptable to God?
- 1. Proverbs 21:3- to do right to all; Rom. 12:1- To offer ourselves to God
- 2. Rom. 14:17, 18- Serving in righteousness, peace and joy
- 3. 2 Cor. 8:12- Do things willingly; I Tim. 2:2,3 Intercede for others
- 4. I Tim. 5:4- Do well to parents; I Pet. 2:20- Suffer patiently
- C. We see the gospel of Christ clearly portrayed for us in this chapter
- 1. v. 7- God tells the sinner through His word that he has sinned
- 2. This brings wrath of God on the sinner-Ps. 5:5, 6; Jer. 4:4; Jn 3:36
- 3. 7 sacrifices- Only hope is perfect blood sacrifice-Heb. 10:14, 9:22 4. V.8- They went to Job who is type of Christ
- 5. Job intervenes for them as Mediator- 1 Tim. 2:5
- 6. Vs. 8, 9 God accepts them through Job-
- D. Job like Christ had everything (1:3) but then not (2 Cor. 8:9; Phi. 2:5-8)
 - 1. Job as type of Christ was afflicted by his friends (Zech. 13:6)
 - 2. Like Christ he was exalted greater (Job 42:10,12) (Phil. 2:9 11)
 - 3. Like Christ he was prolonged and saw offspring (v. 16, 17; Is. 53:10)
