  - i. Easy enough to love people who are like us
  - ii. God's nature is to love
  - iii. God loves that which is opposite to Him John 3: 16
  - iv. A letter about a shirt and a wheelbarrow
  - v. Love is patient and kind
  - vi. Love does not envy or boast
  - vii. It is not arrogant or rude
  - vííí. It does not insist on its own,
    - ix. Is not irritable or resentful
    - x. It does not rejoice in wrong doing but rejoices witht the truth
  - xi. Love bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things endures all things
  - xíí. Love never ends
