## THE COMMANDMENT IS CLEAR (Part II) Deuteronomy 6:1-25

How do we perpetuate obedience to the Great Commandment? (Review)

- Preachers have a <u>great</u> <u>command</u> to preach it (v.1-3).
- 2. Believers have a <u>great</u> commandment to <u>obey</u> (v.4-5).
- 3. Parents have a <u>great</u> responsibility to **communicate** (v.6-9).
- 4. Everyone has a <u>great</u> danger to defeat (v.10-19). "Beware of **blessings**."
  - a. Material blessings can cause us to **forget God** (v.10-12).
  - b. Material blessings can lure us to <u>compromise</u> with the worldly <u>culture</u> (v.13-15).
  - c. Material blessings can condition us to test, tempt or **dare** God to act (v.16-19).

- 5. This generation has great accountability for the next (v.20-25).
  - a. You can't plan quality time.
  - b. You can plan a **quantity** of time when quality time might happen.
  - c. You have limited **opportunities** when they are listening.
  - d. Your opportunity to teach depends on the quality of your **relationship**.
