Sermon: **Psalm 1:1-3**

*The character and blessings of the godly.*

We see:

1. He avoids evil and refuses to be led by it. (v.1)
2. He is diligent to know and to walk in the way of the LORD. (v.2)
3. He is established and nourished by the LORD so that he is fruitful and prosperous. (v.3)

## The Westminster Confession of Faith

### Chapter 14—Of Saving Faith

**WCF 14.1** The grace of faith, whereby the elect are enabled to believe to the saving of their souls,(1) is the work of the Spirit of Christ in their hearts,(2) and is ordinarily wrought by the ministry of the Word:(3) by which also, and by the administration of the sacraments, and prayer, it is increased and strengthened.(4)

**WCF 14.2** By this faith, a Christian believeth to be true whatsoever is revealed in the Word, for the authority of God Himself speaking therein;(1) and acteth differently upon that which each particular passage thereof containeth; yielding obedience to the commands,(2) trembling at the threatenings,(3) and embracing the promises of God for this life and that which is to come.(4) But the principal acts of saving faith are accepting, receiving, and resting upon Christ alone for justification, sanctification, and eternal life, by virtue of the covenant of grace.(5)

**WCF 14.3** This faith is different in degrees, weak or strong;(1) may be often and many ways assailed and weakened, but gets the victory;(2) growing up in many to the attainment of a full assurance through Christ,(3) who is both the author and finisher of our faith.(4)

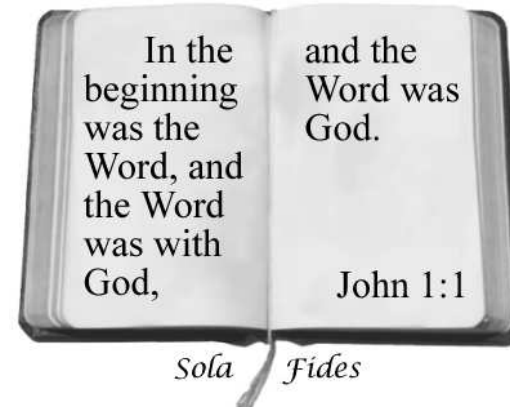
