"The Christ Who Addresses My Deepest Need" John 3:1-15

Jesus Christ faithfully speaks to man's deepest need.

1. A Man in Need of the New Birth

vv. 1-8

(1) The Man Nicodemus (1-2)

"There was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a ruler of the Jews."

-1- His Bio

- Very serious about spiritual things the pursuit of righteousness
- Very well-versed in the Scriptures
- Very gifted

-2- His Present Interest

"This man came to Jesus by night..."

- His earnestness seeking a private interview with Christ
- His apparent fear of man
- His conviction concerning Christ "we know that you are a teacher come from God;

for no one can do these signs that you do

unless God is with him."

Entirely deficient as pertains to salvation!

(2) Jesus Confronts Nicodemus concerning His True Need (3-8)

-1- The Absolute Necessity of the New Birth

"Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

- The starting point of true spiritual life
- Man can see nothing of the things of God without it!
- Man cannot enter the kingdom of God without it!

-2- The Nature of the New Birth

- A radical change! cf. "How can a man be born when he is old?"
- An operation of the Spirit! "unless one is born of water and the Spirit"
- An inward, radical cleansing cf. Ezek. 36
- Man entirely helpless, powerless, unable to bring it about

2. A Man in Need of Simple Faith in Christ

vv. 9-15

(1) Nicodemus Confesses His Ignorance (9)

"How can these things be?"

- (2) Jesus Speaks to the Necessity of Simple Faith in These Truths (10-15)
 - -1- Understanding these things essential to one who would shepherd God's people! 10

 "Are you the teacher in Israel,
 and do not know these things?"
 - -2- They are "as clear as the sun" to all true shepherds! 11 "we speak what we know and testify what we have seen"

(Also as clear as the sun to every true Christian!)

- Unequivocally believed
- Unashamedly proclaimed
- -3- They are among the most basic of spiritual truths and can only be received by faith! 12

"If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things?"

- -4- They center entirely in Jesus Himself; Christ is the object of this true faith 13-15
 - A perfect righteousness achieved by and found in Him alone 13
 - A perfect atonement for sin achieved by His death alone 14-15
