- A. Nicodemus belonged to Jewish Church yet needed to be born again
- B. The reason we need to be born again is to be able to be part of His Kingdom
- C. Jesus' focus was sowing the incorruptible seed of regeneration (1 Peter 1:23)

NEW BIRTH I. THE AUTHOR II. MEANS III. EVIDENCE

I. The Author of the New Birth

- A. The Holy Spirit is the only Author: vs. 8 John 1:12-13 (Eph. 2:1-3)
- B. The Holy Spirit is sovereign in His work: vs. 7-8

II. THE MEANS

- A. Holy Spirit works this mysterious new birth through the Word (the seed)
- B. What is our responsibility if we desire to seek the power of Spirit at work?

III. The Evidence of New Birth

- A. The Holy Spirit's work is always sensed without being visible (John 3:8)
- B. We are to judge His work from the effects: new birth brings a new life
- C. What should we do when we see these effects in our children? (Col. 1:3-5)
