I. His words

A. What:

Luke 9:22; 18:31-34

In addition Matt 17:9, 22-23; 26:31-32 Thu eve!

Also implicit: Matt 12:40; Jn 2:19-22; 16:16-23

B. Why:

Confidence and comfort

II. The ironies

A. His _____ not “remember”, but his _____
did

(Matt 27:63: we remember...)

B. Their intent was to _____ Him
Their attempt produced a startling confirmation!

III. The foolishness of unbelief

A. Jesus' words to His disciples after His resurrection

- Luke 24:25-26: rebuke
- Lk 24:36, 38-40: comfort
So gentle to them: v44-46

B. The way to peace is to **remember**

- The women's fretting and wasted effort
- The men's miserable fear and despair

IV. His promise

- A. The Gospel **will** go to ALL nations (Lk 24:47)
- B. You **will** have His power (Lk 24:49 → Acts 1:4-5, 8 → 2:1ff) and Presence (Matt 28:20)

- C. He **will** come again
Lk 24:49 → Acts 1:4-5 → 7-11
