Declaring Our Faith (unison):

The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God the Father Almighty, Maker of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, Who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. The third day He rose again from the dead. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty. From there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit,

the holy catholic* church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

This creed traditionally dates back to the early 2nd century.

The word "catholic" means "universal", meaning the one true church made up of all believers in Jesus Christ from every tribe, language, people and nation.

Gloria Patri

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end, Amen, Amen.

The Gloria Patri's first line was sung in the church as early as the 2nd century to affirm that God is Triune. The second line was added in the 4th century to emphasize the eternal Deity of Jesus, refuting the Arian heresy that Jesus was not eternally God.

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PROCLAIMING THE WORD OF GOD

Reading of God's Word

Genesis 21.8-21

⁸ And the child grew and was weaned. And Abraham made a great feast on the day that Isaac was weaned. ⁹ But Sarah saw the son of Hagar the Egyptian, whom she had borne to Abraham, laughing. ¹⁰ So she said to Abraham, "Cast out this slave woman with her son, for the son of this slave woman shall not be heir with my son Isaac." ¹¹ And the thing was very displeasing to Abraham on account of his son. ¹² But God said to Abraham, "Be not displeased because of the boy and because of your slave woman. Whatever Sarah says to you, do as she tells you, for through Isaac shall your offspring be named. ¹³ And I will make a nation of the son of the slave woman also, because he is your offspring." ¹⁴ So Abraham rose early in the morning and took bread and a skin of water and gave it to Hagar, putting it on her shoulder, along with the child, and sent her away. And she departed and wandered in the wilderness of Beersheba. ¹⁵ When the water in the skin was gone, she put the child under one of the bushes. ¹⁶ Then she went and sat down opposite him a good way off, about the distance of a bowshot, for she said, "Let me not look on the death of the child." And as she sat opposite him, she lifted up her voice and wept. ¹⁷ And God heard the voice of the boy, and the angel of God called to Hagar from heaven and said to her, "What troubles you, Hagar? Fear not, for God has heard the voice of the boy where he is. ¹⁸ Up! Lift up the boy, and hold him fast with your hand, for I will make him into a great nation." ¹⁹ Then God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water. And she went and filled the skin with water and gave the boy a drink. ²⁰ And God was with the boy, and he grew up. He lived in the wilderness and became an expert with the bow. ²¹ He lived in the wilderness of Paran, and his mother took a wife for him from the land of Egypt.

All: The grass withers, the flowers fade, but the word of our God will stand forever.

- **Series-** *Abraham and Sarah: Walking By Faith- Genesis 12-*
- **Message:** *God Will Take Care of You*
- **Text:** Genesis 21.8-21

The Discord, 8-10

- A celebration to mark Isaac's weening, 8
- What Sarah saw, 9
 - Will not say "Ishmael"
 - Ishmael is laughing/mockng – Galatians 4.29 calls it persecution
 - Ishmael no longer the center of attention, Isaac is
- Sarah's demand, 10
 - Cultural issues and inheritance
 - 17 is the age of Joseph when he was sold into slavery
- Sin has consequences
- Walking by sight and not by faith has consequences

The Distress, 11-14

- Abraham's love for Ishmael was real
 - Abraham was willing to accept Ishmael as he promised child, cf. 17.18
- Evidently Abraham prays
 - Abraham wants God to intervene as he did in Genesis 16
- Verse 12 is an answer
 - God's surprising answer
 - Don't be distressed
 - Quite a request!
- Listen to Sarah
 - Another step in learning to walk by faith
- Isaac is the child of promise and the true heir, not Ishmael
 - The Testament commentary/application
- Reminds Abraham about the promise he has already made concerning Ishmael, 17.20
- An emotional moment
 - How?
 - Obedience and faith

The Departure, 15-21

- Hagar and Ishmael anticipate dying, 15-16
- God is present, 17-19
 - God sees
 - God hears ("Ishmael")
 - God intervenes with water
- God's ongoing care, 20-21

So What About Us?

- God's offer
- Our concerns today
- God's Promise
