INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Before taking up the theme of grieving the Spirit, we must consider the context in which Paul mentions it.
- 2. Paul contrasts the believer's new way of life with the old (4:17-24).
 - a. Paul commands the Ephesians not to live like the other Gentiles (4:17-19)
 - b. Having learned from Christ, the Ephesians are to put off the old man and put on the new (4:20-24).
- 3. Paul commands the believers to walk in love (4:25-5:2).
 - a. The apostle gives a list of examples of putting on and putting off.
 - b. The apostle warns about the sin of grieving the Holy Spirit.

4. APPLICATIONS:

(1) By the Holy Spirit, believers have put off the old man and have put on the new.

(2) By the Holy Spirit, we can walk in holiness.

(3) Grieving the Spirit will come by neglecting Paul's commands or by rebelling against them.
