**UNEMPLOYED RIGHTS, (Part 1)**

**1 Corinthians 9:1-12**

**I. Doctrine: The \_\_\_\_\_ Objectives In the Universe *Supersede* the Exercise of our “Rights”**

A. –This Doctrine Does *Not* \_\_\_\_\_ Or *Impugn* our God  
Given *Privileges*; . . . , (1 Cor. 9:1a, 5)

B. . . . *But* It Does \_\_\_\_\_ Them—For the Glory of  
God, (1 Cor. 9:12b)

**II. Paul's *Developing* \_\_\_\_\_ For his Unique *Unemployed Rights Decision*, vv. 1-12**

A. First, he Wanted To \_\_\_\_\_ his Critics' "*Examination*"  
of him, (see esp. v. 3), vv. 1-7

B. Then, he *Further* \_\_\_\_\_ On his *Biblical* and Legiti-  
mate Ministerial *Prerogatives*, vv. 8-12a

C. Finally, he \_\_\_\_\_ That his *Reason* Was To *Pro-*  
*tect* The *Pristineness* of his Gospel Preaching, v. 12b

**III. What This Text of Scripture \_\_\_\_\_ For *us*, the True  
Church, Today**

A. –In *Principle*, It Means That we *Seek* To  
\_\_\_\_\_ "*Roadblocks*" To The *Knowledge*  
of Christ; . . . , (1 Cor. 9:12a)

B. . . . And This *May* Require Some *Loving* \_\_\_\_\_  
On *our* Parts, (1 Cor. 9:12b)

**Key Verses**—vv. 3, 12b: "*This is my defense to those who would examine me. . . . Nevertheless, we have not made use of this right, but we endure anything rather than put an obstacle in the way of the gospel of Christ.*" (ESV)
