## C. The DOCTRINE of the LOCAL CHURCH. (1 Timothy 3:16)

The written Word of God is designed to point us to the Living Word of God — the Lord Jesus Christ. All sound doctrine from beginning to end centers around the Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, all local church teaching should be derived and developed from the Scriptures with Jesus Christ as the focus.

1.	"- Jesus Christ as the Son
	of God and deity, became a human through the incarnation and virgin birth. Without Jesus Christ coming to be flesh, we would have no perfect sacrifice for our sins. All Christianity stands upon this foundation. (Phil 2:4-6; 1Tim. 2:3-5)
2.	"" – seems to refer to the sum total of Christ's ministry on earth which was performed perfectly and without sin through the power of the Holy Spirit; his miracles, teaching, baptism, crucifixion and resurrection.
3.	"" – angels were involved though out Jesus Christ's earthly ministry, from his birth to his ascension. (Luke 1:26-38, 2:8-14; Matt. 4:11; Acts 1:10-11)
4.	"" - By God's grace, Gentiles became equally blessed with the Jews through the mystery of the Church. (Eph. 3:1-12)
5.	"" – faith is the only correct human response to the preaching of the Gospel. (Acts 16:31; Rom. 1:16; Eph. 2:8-9; Gal. 3:26)
6.	"" – the ascension was the final event of Jesus Christ on earth and indicated that He finished His redemptive work on man's behalf. It also indicates that Jesus Christ is now in the presence of God the Father and that He will come again at the Rapture to take all believers in Christ home to Heaven one day.
