- I. Our worship of God should be \_\_\_\_\_ Vs 1
- A. Our \_\_\_\_\_ about God should bring joy to our mind, hearts, and lips
  - B. Our worship of God should bring joy to \_\_\_\_\_ heart
  - C. Our worship of God should be \_\_\_\_\_ to anyone who wishes to join us
- II. Our worship of God will include: Vs 2-
- A. Our \_\_\_\_\_ in singing and testifying Vs 2-3
    - 1. "Sing forth"-celebrate in music and singing with \_\_\_\_\_ (Cf. Vs 1)
    - 2. Our singing should be about the honor and glory God \_\_\_\_\_ Vs 2a
    - 3. Our singing should be praise to the glory of God-singing to rejoice in Him and make Him appear \_\_\_\_\_ to the worshipers. Vs 2b
  - B. Our \_\_\_\_\_ should be to God about who He is and what He does and has done. Vs 3-4
    - 1. "Speak \_\_\_\_\_ to God"
    - 2. "How your works cause us to \_\_\_\_\_ you"
    - 3. "Your great power no one can overrule or over throw; your enemies will submit to you alone"
  - C. Our worship should demonstrate our complete trust in the \_\_\_\_\_ of God and the total submission of all creation and all created beings to God's supreme rule Vs 4

- A. "Come and see the works of God" Vs 5a
  - B. "He is terrible in his doing toward the children of men" Vs 5b
    - 1. God is to be \_\_\_\_\_
    - 2. That fear comes from what we see Him doing to mankind-both in his loving \_\_\_\_\_ and in his judgment
    - 3. This is a testimony to what God had \_\_\_\_\_ in the past and what He has promised to do in the future
      - a. Parting of the Red Sea and the Jordan River Vs 6
      - b. His past actions \_\_\_\_\_ us of His total rule over everything and everyone Vs 7
    - 4. "Selah"-take time to \_\_\_\_\_ on this! Vs 7b
- IV. Considering who God is and what He has done \_\_\_\_\_ us to praise Him loudly and invite others to join us Vs 8
