 The matters being dealt with were neither petty nor trivial.

2 Thessalonians 3:6-15

The nature of the tradition.

- The consistency of Paul's logic.
- The position's consistency with other Scripture.

#### A DIVISIVE UNREPENTANT BROTHER

Titus 3:9-11

"Heretic" - the Greek conveys the idea of "schismatic, factious, a follower of false doctrine."

Vine - "a self-willed opinion which is substituted for submission to the power of the truth and leads to division and the formation of sects."

- Immoral brother (1 Corinthians 5:11)
- Unequally yoked brother (1 Corinthians
  5:11; 2 Corinthians 6:14)
- Lazy brother (2 Thessalonians 3:6-15)
- **Disobedient** brother (2 Thessalonians 2:15; 3:6-14)
- **Heretical** brother (*Titus 3:10*)
