## BOOK OF 2 KINGS THE REVIVAL UNDER HEZEKIAH 2 KINGS 18-21; 2 CHRONICLES 29-32

## Introduction

HEZEKIAH began to reign in JUDAH after the death of his father AHAZ. What is amazing is that we see HEZEKIAH'S reign was opposite to that of his father! AHAZ was one of the most, if not the most wicked kings that ever reigned over JUDAH up to this point! HEZEKIAH on the other hand was greater than all the kings of JUDAH that came before him and those that would come after him! (2 Kings 18:5)

A lot is said about him in both 2 KINGS 18-21 and 2 CHRONICLES 29-32! So this may take us a few weeks to get through these chapters as we first look at the THE REVIVAL UNDER HEZEKIAH!

- I. WE SEE THE SUMMARY OF HEZEKIAH'S REIGN! (2 KINGS 18:1-8; Cf. 2 CHRONICLES 29:1-2)
  - A. We Are Told Both His Age And The Length Of His Reign. (2 Kings 18:1-2a; 2 Chronicles 29:1a)

    He began to reign at 25 and reigned for 29 years.
  - B. We Are Told Who His Mother Was.
    (2 Kings 18:1b; Cf. 2 Chronicles 29:1b)
    His mother was ABI a/k/a ABIJAH, the daughter of ZECHARIAH.

Remember that we said whenever the mother is mentioned it is believed to be because of the degree of influence she had on her child whether that influence was good or bad.

We also mentioned that some extra-Biblical sources say that his mother was the one responsible for having rescued him from his father trying to pass him through the fire like his siblings!

C. We Are Told The Quality Of His Reign.
(2 Kings 18:3; 2 Chronicles 29:2)
He did that which was right in the sight of the LORD.

- 2. It had been a long time since the *PASSOVER* was observed.
- 3. They could not do it at the proper time because of defilement. (30:2-3)
- 4. There were varied reactions to the invitation to observe. (30:10-14)
- 5. Killing the *PASSOVER* convicted of sin. (30:15-16)
- 6. Some ate the *PASSOVER* without proper cleansing. (30:17-21)

  Hezekiah prayed for the LORD God to pardon them. And the LORD did, because the motive of their heart was heart right.
- 7. HEZEKIAH encouraged the LEVITES who taught and the people responded. (30:22)
- 8. The FEASTS were kept for 7 days. (30:23-27)
- I. HEZEKIAH Had The Idols Destroyed, The Groves Cut Down And The High Places Thrown Down!
  (2 Kings 18:4; 2 Chronicles 31:1)
- J. HEZEKIAH organized the PRIESTHOOD. (31:2-19)
  - a. Tithes and offerings were brought in. (31:5-6)
  - b. The *LORD* blessed the people. (31:10)
  - c. The *PRIESTS* were placed over various functions. (31:11-19)
