Application Questions

These questions are provided for your further study and application of today's sermon. Thoughtfully writing out the answers to these questions will help to drive home the point of today's study. It is also helpful when you are able to discuss your answers with others.

- 1. Read **Psalm 99:1-5**. What kind of praying does a clear awareness of God's holiness preclude?
- 2. Read **Psalm 106:47** and **Psalm 111:9**. Why is a focus on salvation such a prominent and natural complement to pondering God's holiness? How can a thoughtful reflection on both of these at the outset of your focused times of prayer change the way you pray?

3. Read **Psalm 138:2**; **Isaiah 1:10-17** and **Isaiah 5:24** Why is it so important to define the holy character of God

biblically and not simply by intuition or instinct?

4. Read **Hebrews 10:19-22** and **1 Timothy 2:4-5**. How do these passages help to shape our understanding of praying in Jesus name? How can you make sure that "...in Jesus' name" doesn't become a meaningless phrase in your praying?

5. Read **Hebrews 4:14-16**. How do our sin, temptations, and shame sometimes keep us from addressing a holy God in prayer? What particular part of this passage helps you the most in avoiding that problem?
