God is a God of truth and cannot lie.

Man was created to be an image-bearer but sin distorts God's image. Cf. Gen.1:26,27; 4:9; Jn.8:44

In the gospel God's image is being restored.

II. The *Breadth* of the 9th Commandment.

A breach with universal effects.

A breach with serious consequences.
