(See also Daniel 8:12, 24, 25; Daniel 11:36)

3. HIS CONTINUOUS _____, vv.40-45

A. Wars and Rumors of Wars, vv. 40-43

1.) This is "the time of the end" toward the _____ of the Tribulation, Matt.24:6-8.

2.) The battles described here solidify his worldly empire with ten kings under his authority, centered in Jerusalem.

3.) The _____ in this passage could each represent a coalition of other nations with them: the king of the south, the north (v.40), the east (v.44), and "HIM, HE, or HIS," which is the Antichrist (v.40-45).

B. Invasion of the Kings of the _____, v.44

- Many believe this battle coincides with Ezekiel 38-39. While the ultimate fulfillment of Ezekiel 38-39 could well occur at the end of the Millennium, this could be a partial or more immediate fulfillment of this passage.

C. He Establishes his World Capital in _____, v.45

- This happens just before the middle of the Tribulation, when the Antichrist still seems loyal to his covenant with Israel.

4. HIS ULTIMATE _____, v.45

- See also Daniel 8:25; Daniel 9:27; Rev.19:19,20.

- Daniel 11:45b: ... yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him.

Daniel 11:36-45

Daniel: God's Sovereign Rule Over Human History, part 38

- Between Daniel 11:35 and Daniel 11:36 is another _____ that brings us from the times of Antiochus in 164 BC to the times of the Antichrist still in the future!

1.) Many of Daniel's prophecies move from the four great past kingdoms (Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece & Rome) to the future Antichrist and the Second Coming of Christ, skipping the church age (Daniel 2:31-45; Daniel 7:7, 23-24)

2.) The character of this KING (the Antichrist) in v.36-45 is far different from the King Antiochus of verses 21-35. Antiochus worshiped the Greek gods and set up an image of Zeus in the temple. The Antichrist magnifies himself above "EVERY GOD" and does not regard "ANY GOD."

3.) The events of verses 36-45 fit with other prophecies of the future but do not fit with events from the _____.

4.) This king leads to a time of _____ never before seen, which is the Great Tribulation (Daniel 12:1), and corresponds with Matthew 24:21-22.

- This passage describes the character and career of the Antichrist who is fully energized and surrendered to Satan. In his life we see four traits of one who has sold their soul to the devil.

Scripture Reading, Daniel 11:36-12:4

36 And the king shall do according to his will; and he shall exalt himself, and magnify himself above every god, and shall speak marvellous things against the God of gods, and shall prosper till the indignation be accomplished: for that that is determined shall be done.

37 Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.

38 But in his estate shall he honour the God of forces: and a god whom his fathers knew not shall he honour with gold, and silver, and with precious stones, and pleasant things.

39 Thus shall he do in the most strong holds with a strange god, whom he shall acknowledge and increase with glory: and he shall cause them to rule over many, and shall divide the land for gain.

40 And at the time of the end shall the king of the south push at him: and the king of the north shall come against him like a whirlwind, with chariots, and with horsemen, and with many ships; and he shall enter into the countries, and shall overflow and pass over.

41 He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many countries shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, even Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.

42 He shall stretch forth his hand also upon the countries: and the land of Egypt shall not escape.

43 But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians shall be at his steps.

44 But tidings out of the east and out of the north shall trouble him: therefore he shall go forth with great fury to destroy, and utterly to make away many.

45 And he shall plant the tabernacles of his palace between the seas in the glorious holy mountain; yet he shall come to his end, and none shall help him.

12 And at that time shall Michael stand up, the great prince which standeth for the children of thy people: and there shall be a time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time: and at that time thy people shall be delivered, every one that shall be found written in the book.

2 And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

3 And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

4 But thou, O Daniel, shut up the words, and seal the book, even to the time of the end: many shall run to and fro, and knowledge shall be increased.
