- I. The Plot To Betray Jesus (21:37-22:6)
 - A. Jesus would teach in the Temple, then stay the night on the Mount of Olives
 - B. The religious leaders were seeking a way to kill Jesus
 - C. Judas Iscariot, under Satanic influence, agrees to betray Jesus for money
- II. Making Preparations (22:7-13)
 - A. The Passover was one of the most important feasts in all of Judaism
 - B. The meal had to be prepared for: both logistically and spiritually
 - C. The same is true of the Lord's Table today
- III. The Institution of the Lord's Supper (14-23)
 - A. I have desired to eat this Passover with you
 - B. The broken bread
 - C. The shared cup
 - D. Responsibility and Sovereignty
