- 1) Your words are **directing** your relationships (James 3:1-4)
 - a) Like a <u>bit</u>
 - b) Like a <u>rudder</u> "Lose lips <u>sink ships</u>."
- 2) Your words may **<u>destroy</u>** your relationships James 3:5-8
 - a) Like a roaring fire
 - i) A fire starts with a spark
 - ii) A fire spreads with a rush
 - b) Like a ravenous beast
 - i) With our words we **pounce** like predators
 - ii) With our words we **poison** like snakes
- 3) Your words can **<u>delight</u>** your relationships James 3:9-12
 - a) Like a <u>refreshing</u> fountain
 - b) Like **reenergizing** fruit

The power of the tongue: Apply it!

- The **<u>direction</u>** of your relationships is decided by your words
- The **<u>condition</u>** of you relationship is decided by your words
- The **<u>destiny</u>** of your relationship is decided by your words
- Only a decision in your **<u>heart</u>** can control your words
 - Use helpful words Pro 15:1; 25:11; 16:24
 - Refuse hurtful words Pro 10:19; 14:1-3; 26:18-22
