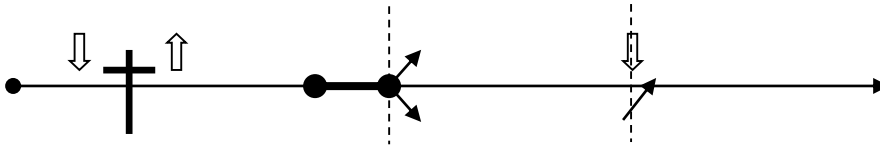


# “The Time For RESTORING All Things”

## The Apostles’ Claims About Heaven And The Resurrection

Acts 1:3-11; 3:11-21 (911); Rom. 8:18-25 (944)

Several edgy, public sermons by the Apostles form the early framework of the theology of Acts. Today we regard Peter’s SECOND of three sermons – this one ringing through the Temple courts. The opening for this discourse was a miraculous healing by Peter and John at the Gate Beautiful (v 2). As a healed cripple clung to Peter (v 11), he delivered a sweeping, biblical sermon. Today we consider the doctrine of Heaven in Peter’s sermon and the other apostolic writings. Live in the eternal light of Jesus the person and Heaven the place.
