JOHN: The glory of Jesus—Part 19

Sermon: **John 7:37,38**

The glory of Jesus in calling all who are thirsty to come to Him.

We see:

1. This call is proclaimed in the midst of unbelief, doubt, and mocking.
2. This call shows Jesus to be the fulfillment of the feast and is thus to *come* to Him and *drink*.
3. This drinking results in *rivers of living water* flowing out from within the believer.

The Westminster Confession of Faith

WCF 2.2 God hath all life,(1) glory,(2) goodness,(3) blessedness,(4) in and of Himself; and is alone in and unto Himself all-sufficient, not standing in need of any creatures which He hath made,(5) not deriving any glory from them,(6) but only manifesting His own glory in, by, unto, and upon them: He is the alone fountain of all being, of whom, through whom, and to whom are all things,(7) and hath most sovereign dominion over them, to do by them, for them, or upon them whatsoever Himself pleaseth.(8) In His sight all things are open and manifest;(9) His knowledge is infinite, infallible, and independent upon the creature,(10) so as nothing is to Him contingent, or uncertain.(11) He is most holy in all His counsels, in all His works, and in all His commands.(12) To Him is due from angels and men, and every other creature, whatsoever worship, service, or obedience He is pleased to require of them.(13)

The Belgic Confession

Article 1—There is only one God

We all believe with the heart and confess with the mouth that there is only one God, who is a simple and spiritual Being; He is eternal, incomprehensible, invisible, immutable, infinite, almighty, perfectly wise, just, good, and the overflowing fountain of all good.

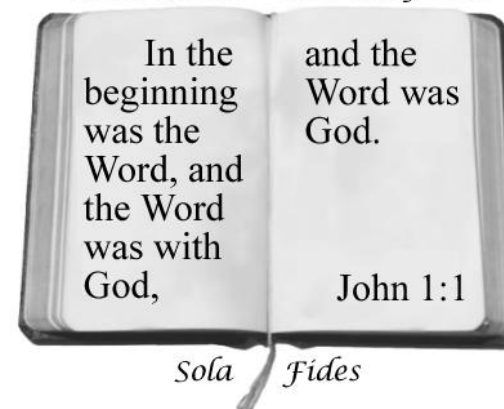

4. In the OT, what did the ceremonial “pouring of water” refer to?
5. The two verses of our text show what it means to *come to Me and drink*. What does it mean?!
6. Who does the *his* refer to in v.38 (*out of his heart will flow*)?
7. How is it possible, that *out of his heart will flow rivers of living water*? And, what does this mean?
