Consider & Discuss (Be Transformed!)

- How will all Israel be saved?
- What are the various meanings of "all Israel"?
- In what condition do both Israel and the Gentile nations find themselves (30-32)?
- Is Paul teaching a universal salvation for all people (30-32)? If not what is the scope of God's mercy?
- **Community Group Focus Question:** Set aside a minimum of 5 minutes before we meet to be still before God in order to hear Him in this passage of Scripture. Think about the truth God is revealing in Romans 11:25-32 that God is bringing about the salvation of "all Israel" by way of their current partial hardening. How would God have this truth transform you, your thinking, and your doings? Consider how this informs your fellowship, discipleship, evangelism... Ask Him. Listen. Take notes. With humility, thankfulness, share what you have heard from God with your brothers and sisters in Christ for their edification and receive what they have discovered and shared for yours.
