INTRODUCTION

- A. What is our Global Missions Focus?

Mission: Making sure that everyone in the world hears the Gospel of Jesus Christ correctly and planting New Testament churches among those who believe.

“23 So when they had appointed elders in every church, and prayed with fasting, they commended them to the Lord in whom they had believed.

24 And after they had passed through Pisidia, they came to Pamphylia.

25 Now when they had preached the word in Perga, they went down to Attalia.

26 From there they sailed to Antioch, where they had been commended to the grace of God for the work which they had completed.

27 Now when they had come and gathered the church together, they reported all that God had done with them, and that He had opened the door of faith to the Gentiles.” Acts 14:23-27

DECLARE HIS GLORY BY FULFILLING HIS MISSION

I. INTRODUCTION

- A. The **meaning** of “declare” in Psalm 96:3.
“Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples.” Psalm 96:3
- B. Jesus is our **example** in declaring his glory.
“... because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:”
I Peter 2:21b

II. HOW DID JESUS FULFILL HIS MISSION?

- A. The Gospel according to **Paul**.
*“1 Paul, a bondservant of Jesus Christ, called to be an apostle, separated to the gospel of God
2 which He promised before through His prophets in the Holy Scriptures,
3 concerning His Son Jesus Christ our Lord, who was born of the seed of David according to the flesh,
4 and declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead.”* Romans 1:1-4

- B. Son of **David** fulfilling.
God’s promises to the fallen humanity.
*“And I will put enmity Between you and the woman,
And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.”*
Genesis 3:15
- **Abraham**
“And in thy seed shall all the nations of the earth be blessed; because thou hast obeyed my voice.”
Genesis 22:18 KJV

- **David**
*“7 Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.
8 The Lord sent a word against Jacob, And it has fallen on Israel.
9 All the people will know— Ephraim and the inhabitant of Samaria— Who say in pride and arrogance of heart:”* Isaiah 9:7-9

III. FULFILLING HIS MISSION BY HIS ACTIONS

- A. Declared Son of **God**.
Declared here means: “defined, marked out by sure signs”, Cambridge Bible for Schools and Colleges
- B. Exegesis: The spirit of **holiness**!
“For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.”
Psalm 16:10
- C. The meaning of the **resurrection**: Jesus fulfilled His mission by...
- **Obedience** to the Father.
*“6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God,
7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men.
8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.”*
Philippians 2:6-8
