Malachi 3:6-12

- I. God's call
 - A. <u>R</u> to Me

Israel's Q: what have we done wrong? What's the problem?

B. Stop <u>R</u> Me

Withholding tithes

C. Start R in Me

Test Me in this

Give more than you think you can afford and see if I will take care of you

Different from our situation:

- 1. I cannot tell you what to give to the Cap Gifts Campaign
- 2. But I also cannot tell you what to give regularly (ICor 16:2)

But is grace less than law? II Cor 8:2ff; 9:6-7

Application to our situation:

We hold back from giving to God because we are afraid He will not provide enough for us

- II. God's character: faithful! Specifically in 3 ways:
 - A. Faithful to His covenant: v6 Contrast Edom: 1:2-5 (Jacob's brother)
 - B. Faithful to His grace: v7
 If you return to Him today, He will return to you.
 But He has not promised tomorrow
 - C. Faithful in His provision: 10-11 Not meager but abundant!

III. God's Glory: v12

God wants the world to see how He takes care of His people

Not necessarily wealthy in material things, but rich in the Kingdom: v17-18 (cf. James 2:5) Pick up on this next week....
