Believing the Lord, Part 1 Genesis 15:1-21

Main Point:

Instead of becoming disillusioned with God's Word, be reassured by Him so that you keep believing.

- 1. Like Abram, you can sometimes become disillusioned with God's Word.
- 2. God reassures your faith in times of disillusionment by meeting your concerns with confirmation of His Word.
- 3. God reassures your faith in times of disillusionment by telling you in advance that such situations will come.
- 4. God reassures your faith in times of disillusionment by having sealed His promises to you with a covenant.
- 5. Being reassured by God, keep believing His Word.
