Discussion Questions

The following questions are designed to be used by parents in discussing the sermon with their children, but can be used by anyone in discussing the sermon with others.

1. What stood out to you in this sermon? Why?
2. Can you think of an example of a time when God has strengthened you in your weakness?
3. Timothy may have been asking himself, “Why should I be a faithful servant of the Lord, when the cost is so high?” What was Paul’s response to that?
4. What does it mean in verse 9 when it says, “But the Word of God is not bound”?
5. Does the doctrine of election in verse 10 mean that we are to sit back and enjoy life knowing that God will save His elect?
6. The context helps us understand what verse 11 is referring to when it says, “if we have died with Him.” What is it referring to?
7. Verse 13 says that “He (Jesus) remains faithful.” According to the context, in what way is Jesus faithful?

Going Deeper

These questions are designed for the believer to use in prayer with his/her Lord, and in discussion with brothers and sisters in the Lord:

1. How did this sermon challenge your thinking or grow your understanding?
2. What pressures sometimes displace Christ from being the preeminent focus of your thoughts?
3. How are you doing at “remembering Jesus”?
4. What can you do to help you constantly “remember Jesus”?
