### 3 **...Salvation For Everyone Who Believes...**

- Romans
  - Paul establishes the priority of the gospel; Romans 1:1, 16
  - Paul declares how we are not saved; Romans 3:9-12, 20
  - Paul clarifies how we are saved; Rom. 3:24-25
  - Paul gives examples of salvation by grace in the OT; Rom. 4:1-4
  - Paul explains the relationship our salvation has with our daily Christian walk

### 4 **The Fruit that Abounds to Your Account**

- Personal Encouragement
- 2,268 Sermons
  - Focus on Jesus Christ as Savior
  - Appeal to believers to walk as they were saved
  - Purpose of the church

### 5 **...Who Deceives the Whole World**

- The ruler of this world deceives
- God is often maligned when verses are taken out of context
  - Such as Matthew 27:46
- Not just the world, believers may also be deceived, 2 Cor. 11:3
- The solution to deception?
  - 2 Tim. 3:13-17

### 6 **Comparing Spiritual Things with Spiritual**

- 1 Cor. 14:34 in its proper context
- Greater context – God's grace toward a carnal church
- Immediate context – Order within the church, 1 Cor. 14:40
- God is a God of order
  - Gave specific roles/instructions to men and women

### 7 **Comparing Spiritual Things with Spiritual**

- God has determined that within the church, men should be appointed to teach and to lead
- Has nothing to do with equality or worth, but is a matter of decency and order
- A man and woman have equal ground, but different positions
  - Gen. 1:26-29
  - This is a God-established order and not a human order

### 8 **Search the Scriptures**

- Evaluate the history of God's treatment of women
  - What has God done?
  - What has God said?
  - What is His "track record"?
- Track record - The things that someone has done or achieved in the past regarded especially as a way to judge what that person or thing is likely to do in the future
- What about Paul?

### 9 **Search the Scriptures**

- Paul's track record
  - Consider how Paul addresses women in Romans 16
- God's track record
  - Consider Hagar, Genesis 16:11
  - Consider the penalty for rape
  - Consider women's rights in Numbers 27:1-11
  - Consider the woman at the well, John 4
  - Consider Mary, John 11:2; 12:3
  - Consider Martha, John 11:5, 25

### 10 **Search the Scriptures**

- Consider Christ's genealogy
  - Tamar, a Canaanite, Gentile, adultress
  - Rahab, a Canaanite, Gentile, harlot
  - Ruth, a Moabite, Gentile, convert
  - Bathsheba, Hittite, Gentile, adultress
